

RAYMOND E. GATES WAS COPILOT OF CHARLES J. TheLEN JR.'S CREW When It ARRIVED AT the 306th ON 21 MARCH 1943. The NAVICATOR WAS SIDNEY S. MILLER AND THE BOMBOLIER WAS GEORGE L. LEWIS. The CREW WAS Shot down ON 5 MAY APRIL 1943 AND WERE TOGETHER IN STALAGE LUFT 111.
