He is a Member of The 306th B Grp, 369th B Sqd.
and was at Thunleigh, England from 8-43 till 4-11-44
when his B-17 was shot down over Stettin. He
was in Major James S. Opldyke's Crew. Major Opldyke's
Obit is in April 94 issue. From this Crew only
Jones and Flynn are living today.

He is listed as William R. L. Jones on your records,
to me he is Mr. Bill. After being shot down, he
was a P.O.W. from 4-11-44 till 5-5-45 in Stalag
XVII-B in Krems Austria.

Mr. Bill has related many of the good times in
England and also the horrors of being a P.O.W.

To Him and to each of you, Thank you sounds
insufficient But Thank you - and God Bless.
