

The following teletype received from U.K. Base: "ON 23, 24, 25, 26, 30, and 31 DECEMBER AND 1 JANUARY JOURNEYS BY RAIL BEYOND 20 MILES FOR PERSONNEL ON LEAVE, FURLOUGH AND PASS IS PROHIBITED.

THE ONLY EXCEPTION WILL BE IN CASES OF EMERGENCY. IN SUCH CASES PASSES WILL BE ENDORSED IN RED INK ON THE FACE OF THE PASS BY THE CO OF THE UNIT WITH THE WORDS QUOTE AUTHORIZED TO TRAVEL BY RAIL UNQUOTE. THOSE ALREADY ON LEAVE WILL BE AUTHORIZED TO RETURN TO THEIR PROPER STATIONS BY TRAIN ON THE DATES SPECIFIED ABOVE. RTCS WILL ENDORSE PASSES TO GIVE EFFECT TO THIS WHERE NECESSARY.
