INFORMATION:

1. PERSONAL AFFAIRS:

Reimbursement for Transportation of Dependents of Military Personnel to the United States.

By authority published in War Department Letter, Subject: "Return of Dependents from Overseas" dd 23 November, 1944, all military personnel whose dependents traveled prior to issuance of permanent change of station orders, and subsequent to 1 July, 1944, may advise such dependents to submit a claim for reimbursement to the Chief of Transportation, Army Service Forces, Washington, D. C. Showing: (a) Vessel on which travel was performed, (b) Dates and ports of arrival and departure, (c) Amount paid for water transportation, and (d) To whom paid.

The term "dependents" included herein refers only to wives and children of military personnel.

Additional general information may be obtained by consulting the Personal Affairs Officer, Station Personnel Section, Headquarters.
