SUGGESTION: "Why is it that MP's with essential jobs are detailed to clean up the Red Cross here Camp, when it is a charitable and well financed organization?"

The Red Cross is subject to the same sanitation rules as military functions on the Station and must have help if they are to stay open. As a result of this suggestion only volunteers will be used at the Red Cross and they will be paid.
