INFORMATION

1. The following T&A received from 1st Air Division is quoted for information of all concerned:

"ON EACH STA OF THIS COMD TWO BOMBARDMENT ACFT AND TWO FTR ACFT JETN CARS WILL BE ON DISPLAY. ACFT NOT AVAIL ON SAMS WILL BE ARRANGED BY THIS HQ. AT ALCONBURY AN ADDITIONAL DISPLAY OF ACFT WILL BE FURNISHED BY THE 11TH SQUADRON OF THIS HQ. AL STAs WILL HOLD OPEN HOUSE FROM 1300 TO 1800 HRS ON THAT DAY. THE 67TH FTR WG WILL FURNISH A FORMATION OF FTR ACFT AS LRG AS POSSIBLE TO FLY OVER ACTIVE STAs AND HQ OF THIS COMMAND, AND IN VICINITY OF IMPORTANT TOWNS WITHIN THE DIV AREA AT SCHEDULES TO BE ANNOUNCED LATER. PICTORIAL DISPLAYS AND QUALIFIED COMMENTATORS WILL OUTLINE THE GROWTH OF THE AF, THE DEVELOPMENT AND RESULT OF AIR POWER IN THE EUROPEAN WAR, AND STRESS THE USE OF PROBLEMS RESULTS OF AIR POWER IN THE JAPANESE CONFLICT. REPRESENTATIVES, SPORTS, ETC., WILL BE LEFT TO THE DISCRETION OF STA COMMANDERS, WHO ARE AUTH TO PROVIDE PROPERLY SUPERVISED TRANSPORTATION TO TRANSPORT GUESTS FROM NEARBY AREAS FREQUENTED BY STA PERSONNEL. STA COMMANDERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR FURNISHING APPROPRIATE AND COMPETENT ITEMS TO CONDUCT VISITORS ABOUT THE STA AND TO EXPLAIN EQUIP AND EXHIBITS. IT IS POINTED OUT THAT THE BASIC PURPOSE OF AIR FORCE DAY IS FOR OUR OWN PERSONNEL, MANY OF WHOM, DUE TO THE PRESS OF WAR, HAVE NOT HAD THE OPPORTUNITY TO FULLY APPRECIATE THE GROWTH AND RESULT OF AIR POWER. STA COMMANDERS WILL HOLD THE ORDER OF THE DAY, TO BE DISTRIBUTED LATER, TO ALL PERSONNEL AT AN APPROPRIATE TIME DURING THE PERIOD OF OPEN HOUSE. DETAILED REPORT OF PLANS TO COMPLY WITH ABOVE WILL REACH THIS HEADQUARTERS NOT LATER THAN 1400 HRS, 26 JULY. INFORMATION FOR THE SCRAPBOOK, CONSISTING OF STORIES, PICTURES AND CLIPPINGS FROM LOCAL PAPERS, ETC., WILL REACH THIS HEADQUARTERS ON OR BEFORE 8 AUGUST." ---TURNER COMMDR DIV ONE---
