INFORMATION:

1. CORRESPONDENCE:

1. FOI will be substituted for par 11, Cir 6, HQ AFMUSA, 17 Jan 45 pending revision:

FOI items will not be mentioned directly or indirectly in correspondence

- A. Efficiency, Training, Strength, Morale or Detailed Organ of US or Allied Armed Forces or Units thereof.

- B. Signs or markings used to identify organs, transport or baggage.

- C. Classified supplies, equip or mil armament of any kind.

- D. Details of movements of mil, Air Force or Naval organ to from or within any theater of operations. Pers may reveal details of movements to this theater which occurred more than six months prior to date of letter being written, which details will include designation of ports of embarkation and debarkation, dates of arrival and departure, names of transport and length of voyage.

- E. Condition, present use, or probable extension of ports, transport facilities, harbors, or signal comm, including extent of demolition and

repair, unless official release has been made.

F. Details of operations by or against enemy on land, sea or in air, which might reveal tactical methods. Pers may reveal experiences in combat including locations, dates, and unit designations, provided tactical methods are not revealed and classified equip is not mentioned.

G. Forecasts, plans, or orders for future operations or movements either known or surmised.

H. Criticism or statements of a disparaging nature which would bring our armed forces or those of our allied or mil govt in occupied areas into disrepute.

I. Any info regarding casualties including injuries or death by accident or natural causes, except that indiv casualties may be mentioned after official notification to next of kin. (in absence of notification of official release unit censors will assume that casualty has been released thirty days after notice has gone forward from unit to AG Casualty Div Hq AFOSM APO 887). Pers suffering wounds or injuries (or pers auth to write for such pers including American Red Cross representatives) may write about their own wounds or injuries five days after incurrence.

J. Subversive material of any kind.

K. Any info regarding enemy sabotage, espionage, or subversive activities actual or rumored, unless official release has been made.

L. Atrocities against enemy or any actual or rumored breaches of Geneva Convention or rules of land warfare, unless official release has been made.
