SUGGESTION: EXTEND LIBERTY RUN TO MIDNIGHT. ANSWER: Paragraph 3c, 1 AD Instruction 80-2, dated 29 Nov 1944 provides that "Liberty Run" vehicles will depart from the specified cities for return to station not later than 2300 hours.

SUGGESTION: "It so happens that there are other outfits on this base besides the I.P. outfit that have to work 24 hours a day or there about, and we think that we should be able to eat at midnight also."

ANSWER: ~~Anyone working at night is entitled to eat at midnight.~~ Due to the reduction in rations we can't provide food for all the people who come in from liberty runs and the last show. The best way of eating at midnight is for your department head to make arrangements in advance with the Mess Officer.

SUGGESTION: "Please put salt in the oatmeal ---- How about keeping the dogs from ---- on the table legs".

ANSWER: Salt is put in the oatmeal to suit the taste of the majority. Too little is better than too much. Additional salt is available at each table, if an individual desires any more.

The only practical way to keep dogs out of the Mess Hall is by the combined effort of all per sonnel who eat in the Mess Hall. If you see a dog enter the Mess Hall run him out. We haven't been able to teach the dogs to read the bulletin board.
