ANSWER: S. B. believes that any conclusion concerning redeployment is premature. Redeployment regulations are intended to be fair to all, and men in the States won't have enough points to get out unless they are returned combat veterans and we are agreed that they should be first.

The rest of us don't want to spend a fourth winter here either, but we don't have any information "from a competent authority" that can be released at this time.
