THE GREMLINS HAD A GOOD WEEK OF BASEBALL WINNING THREE GAMES AND LOSING A CLOSE ONE TO GRAPTON-UNDERWOOD.

S/SGT. KAMIEFSKI PITCHED THE LOSS AND TO 4:03 WIN OVER FOLEY WORTH, LAST YEARS CHAMPS, ALLOWING SIX HITS.

CPL. GENE THOMPSON TUNED IN A ONE HIT MASTER PITCHER IN BEATING HARRINGTON 4 TO 0. THOMPSON SCORED THE ONLY RUN OF THE GAME RACING FROM SECOND ON AN INFIELD OUT.
