GRELLINS SLIDE ALCON-FALCONS  
IN HOME CENTER 6-5

BEFORE AN ENTHUSIASTIC CROWD OF LOCAL ROOTERS WILKINSON'S GRELLINS BARRIED OFF A 6 TO 5 VICTORY OVER THE ALCON-FALCONS IN AN EXCITING BATT-LE FRIDAY, APRIL 20TH OF THE BASE ATHLETIC LEAGUE.

THE GRELLINS GOT OFF TO A GOOD START WHEN 1/SGT. VIGONNI WENT OFF IN THE FIRST INNING WITH A SINGLE, 1/2. REMILNER'S ONE RUNNED HIM TO SECOND AND AMER SGT. CARROLL REACHED BASE ON AN ERROR C.M. THOMPSON MADE A SHINE TO CENTER DURING IN THE FIRST INN.

THOMAS HIT DOUBLE EARLY IN THE FOURTH WHEN C.M. ONLY HIT ONE, SCORE SECOND AND SCORED ON C.M. CARROLL'S SINGLE TO LEFT.

IN THE SEVENTH THE LOCALS AP-PEARED TO HAVE THE GAME WOUND UP SCORING TWO TO ONE WITH VIGONNI'S DOUB-LE, CARROLL'S TRIPLE HIT AND THOM-SON'S SECOND SINGLE.

THE ALCON-FALCONS SAW ON A RES-PIRANCE IN THEIR HALF OF THE EIGHTH SCOR-ING FIVE RUNS TO FORCE HEAD BUT THE GRELLINS CAME BACK TO LIE IT UP IN THEIR HALF ON SUCCESSIVE SHINES BY QUAY AND SCHULP AND WILKINSON'S STOLE BY SGT. COULSON.

BOTH TEAMS SENT SCORERS IN THE NINTH AND WENT SEVEN TO SIX.
