1140. Flight to Paris for school personnel will be de-
loyed till at least 1530 - it may not take off
today at all. Further information will come later.
- 1150 Flight to Paris scrubbed until 0900 hrs 16 Aug
- 1230 R-25 flight to scrubbed for today.
- 1240 all Casey Jones a/c on the deck.
- 1300 ON watch Capt. [unclear] off watch Lt. [unclear]
- 1305 Division informs us all a/c appropriated exp
for Emergency 17 official bus. (Out to V.J. say)
- 1325 Col. Ashworth says C-47's in 10830 entry above
will now be here today - around 1800 hrs.
Col. Ashworth will check into Billings &
Gane.
