Only our navigator, Ted Pochily, and I survived and spent the next 21 months in a German P.O.W. camp. It was only our third mission. Our pilot was Bill Cunningham and the co-pilot was Walter Bolte.

I regret that I will be unable to attend the reunion but want to get on your mailing list, in case you ever come south for a reunion. Also, if you maintain records for the group, you will know what happened to me and Pochily. Ted's address is 736 Pearse Rd., Schenectady, New York 12309. Ted is fine and I saw him last No-vember for the first time in 35 years.

I would appreciate hearing from you. I now reside in Palm Coast, Florida, semi-retired from General Electric Company.
