Dear Mr Strong,

After almost four years I feel I am ready to sort out the souvenirs that Edmund kept from his years in England, believe me he was deeply affected by that period of his life from early 1942 when we first met until November 1945 when he came back to the US. He was not a hero, but he went and did the job he knew and I'm sure he did it well. He was not well educated, he was taken out of high school to work and help his parents, but he could fix anything and make anything with his hands. Now - I have found pictures of the 1208th taken Dec 24th 1944 in front of a B17. There are others of the christening of "Roe of York." I was visiting Thurleigh for a few days

at that time when I saw the royal entourage coming from the village, it was quite an unusual sight in those days, it was quite a treat to see the Royal Family.

I still have his uniform, cleaned and wrapped in tissue and plastic for over 50 years, he removed the royal insignias "hash marks" stripes etc. and put them on black velvet in a frame.

There are week-end and other passes and other odds and ends. Any of this you could use in the museum I will send, just let me know.

The model B17 he made and a sign that says "306th First Over Germany" will remain in the room.

When the fellows were in training some I recognise as some we knew at Chelveston and moved to Thurleigh when it was turned over from the P.A.F I have a picture of what was then
