I wrote this article to send to another paper but as I read the latest 306th Echoes I saw a picture of the Eagle Beaver. As you read the story of my mission you can see that my plane was the Puttercup. On Oct. 9 43 a request was made for a volunteer to go on a mission. Since this would have been my last mission - I volunteered to go - as the ball turret gunner. After the flight to Gdynia, Norway was over - we all posed for this photo. This is the original crew of the Eagle Beaver, except me - the gunner in the back. extreme left. I was wearing a parachute. After the mission I came back to the 368th Bomb Sq of A.

This photo is displayed in the Smithsonian Institute in Washington D.C. & included in the DAV Calendar for 1995 (month of April) I don't have the names of the men in the photo because this was not my original crew. However, since it's the only picture I have I would like to - (if it's to be printed) have anyone who knows anyone in the photo to supply names. Maybe someone out there may recognize himself, and send in some information.

The picture of the 368th Bomb Squadron was taken May 1943.
