Dear Steve:

You have pretty much all of my file on 24 Apt 44 raid.

I did a little looking around through other things and didn't find anything worth sending along to you. It was one of three missions in which we lost 10 a/c/. Thus, it is fairly distinctive in the 306th history, but not for others.

I think the only official report you are going see concerning your father after his return from Switzerland is that contained on his crew's interrogation form. If there is anything else, it did not make its way into the 306th combat file, and if I had seen anything such at National Archives I would certainly have grabbed it.

I looked through other crew interrogations and did not note any special notes about your Dad's plane.

Checked Roger Freeman's "Mighty Eighth War Diary and there was nothinng of note there.

I think you have pretty much all there is to tell about this one.
