This is a PERMANENT change of station.

In lieu of subsistence a flat per diem of seven dollars (\$7.00) is authorized for travel and for periods of temporary duty enrute to final destination when necessary for officers and flight officers, in accordance with existing law and regulations. Payment of mileage is not authorized. Such times as the individual is billeted and subsisted as outlined in VD Memorandum W-35-2-42, September 30, 1942, his per diem will be suspended.

A flat per diem of seven dollars (\$7.00) is authorized for enlisted men for travel and for periods of temporary duty enroute to final destination in accordance with existing law and regulations, if travel is performed by air. For travel by rail and for periods of delay enroute to final destination, monetary allowance, in lieu of rations and quarters is prescribed in accordance with AR 35-4520.
