I was wearing an old A-2 jacket so it rather helped me get close - I got talking with one of the crew members and was able to get inside of the old bird - a lot of things flashed through my mind as I made my way up to the nose and mean time the rest of the crew had arrived - one man had an old B-15 jacket on and we commented about the age of ^{our} jackets - When the man pulled his old B-15 jacket off I was flabbergasted to see the old ~~Pearl~~ ^{Alaska} H Patch and I said 367th T. He looked funny and said yes' and then we really got to talk - He was DELTON BURGARDNER 1200 31st ST Houston TX 77002 a former 368th Pilot.
