4. RELIGIOUS SERVICES FOR MAY OF 1944

- a. Protestant Services - Sunday morning services will be held in the Post Chapel at 0900 hours, 7 May, 1944. On Sunday evening the regular Bible Study and Fellowship will meet in the Chaplain's Office at 1900 hours.

5. PAYOUT DEDUCTIONS FOR LAUNDRY AND CLEANING
