2. From 11 Oct/44 through 30 Oct/44, there will be present at the Dispensary a travelling Dental Team. They will chean the teeth of all Enlisted Personnel who so wish. It is recommended that all Enlisted Personnel who are interested report earl to the Dispensary for an appointment.

3. Soldier Voting on this Station will be on 10 October 1944, Each Organization will have facilities for voters to ballot in Secret.

The Federal Mar Ballot will be used on this date. (Ballots furnished by States will be mailed back immediately upon receipt and are not to be held up until 10 October 1944). The Federal Mar Ballot is a supplemental ballot to be furnished Soldiers who meet the following requirements:

a. That you are an eligible voter from one of the twenty (20) States authorizing the use of these Federal War Ballots. (See Soldier Voting Poster No. 2).

b. That prior to 1 September 1944, you mailed application for State Absented Ballot. This was usually done on W.B.C. Form No. 1 (Postal Card).

g. That prior to 1 October 1944, you have not received the State Absentee

Ballot that you requested. (Par. b above).

Each Organization has a Soldier Voting Officer. Consult him if you have any doubt about details as to Voting. Read SOLDIER VOTING POSTERS NOS-1-2-3-4 and 5.
