## THE SPORTSLITE

### THURLEIGH GREMLINS TRIP HARRINGDON 25-0, SELLON P. O. BOX 1001

Sparked by the brilliant broken field running and passing of Pfc. Wollen the Thurleigh Gremlins crushed the Harringdon eleven 25 to 0 before an enthusiastic mixed crowd of GIs and civilians at the Goldington Rd. Rugby Grounds in Bedford.

In the closing minutes of the first period Wollen returned a Harringdon punt galloping 60 yds for the first Thurleigh tally. Scoring for the first half ended when Wollen tossed a touchdown pass to end Visconti. Both attempts at conversion failed.

The Gremlins moved toward pay dirt early in the third quarter by a series of short runs climaxed by Wollen's romp through the Harringdon team with the aid of some beautiful blocking for 5 yds and a third touchdown. Thurleigh's last touchdown was tallied on another Wollen pass, this time to Lt. Bowers. Wollen booted the extra point.
