- 0750 It Rained on. It Carlie off.
- 0930 Airfield inspected and S-Clear of obstructions.
Work will be started on P/W 30 (asphalt) Mon.
- 1110 morning - Clerk of Ops told to notify F.C. Mon.
morning before starting work.
- 1210 Off It Rained. On It Apin
- 1330 Goodwin Rd.
- 1735 One a/c at R-25 to come SCS on
- 1810 In It Rained - off It Apin.
- 2000 Notified by Gp. Ops that Casey Jones scrubbed
for 19 Aug.
- 20 Last a/c (B-17-554) on ground.

Sunday Aug 19.

- 0815 Off Hatch to Rosey, On Lt Apin.
- 1030 1 AD advises Turnhouse long runway will
be serviceable in about 3 days. Ops notif.
- 1110 Quick Carlie off Lt Apin
- 1130 Inspected airfield -
- 1215 On Lt Apin Off to Carlie.
- 1330 Goodwin Rd.
- 1715 Capt MacLaff called to say that no aircraft can be
cleared for Gibraltar or the Azores unless cleared
from Group Ops immediately before duty. F.C.O.
signs the clearance, the C-47 arrived at Gib with
4 minutes of gas.
